

**THE CHITTAGONG HILL-TRACTS  
CINEMATOGRAPH REGULATION, 1954**

**East Bengal Regulation No. I of 1955**

[2<sup>nd</sup> February, 1955]

*A Regulation to apply the Cinematograph Act, 1918, to the Chittagong Hill-tracts.*

Whereas it is expedient to apply the Cinematograph Act, 1918, to the Chittagong Hill-tracts;

And Whereas by sub-section (2) of section 92 of the Government of India Act, 1935, the <sup>1</sup>[Government] is empowered to make regulations for the good governance of any area in which is for the time being an excluded or a partially excluded area;

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the said powers and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the <sup>2</sup>[Government] is pleased to make the following Regulation:-
